- <u>ACHIL Platform</u>: Aeronautical Computer Human Interaction Lab. The ACHIL platform analyses and designs operational systems involving human operators (pilots, controllers and engineers).
- <u>CBTDyn / ELSA</u>: Computer-based training (CBT) system for working on multiple aspects of a controller's workflow: phraseology, flight-data integration, conflict detection and resolution, strip management in a paper-strip environment, HMI handling in a stripless environment, etc.
- **SVS**: Shared Virtual Sky: instant buddy system for air traffic simulators with real-time cockpit simulators.
- **<u>Dynamic sectorisation</u>**: Optimal adaptation of airspace sectorisation in accordance with changes in the control load over time.
- **Cop Optimizer**: Optimisation of aircraft sequencing above a navigation point.
- <u>Bagage 3DX</u>: 3D, interactive and virtual inspection and handling of the inside of luggage based on the volumetric exploration of data.
- <u>ATC Supervisor</u>: catalogue of training programmes initial, continuing, master's and specialised master's.

ENAC's participation in WAC 2018 once again confirms its position as a leader in ATM training and research.
